



Step 1: Visit Safe Riders Safety Awareness.org


Step 2: From the "The Course" dropdown, Select Be Prepared for Your Ride.




Step 3: Read the Overview, select Curriculum



Step 4: Review all of the material in the Curriculum and be sure to watch the videos as they do have answers to questions on section quizzes and the final test.



Step 5: At the end of each page, a NEXT box will appear to take you to the next Curriculum. Once you've completed all Curriculum, take the Section Quiz.



Step 6: Repeat until all 5 Sections have been reviewed.

Step 7: <u>Click here</u> to take the <u>Snowmobile Safety Awareness Program Test</u>. This test consist of 50 questions worth 2 points each. You must score 90 points or more to pass the course and receive your Certificate to attend the Snowmobile Riders Course.

NOTE: Once you press "Submit" the test will automatically be sent to Fort Wainwright Outdoor Recreation for review. If you've passed, your Certificate will be sent to the email address provided.
